- You will work at the Paris-Saclay Applied Economics research unit in close collaboration with the CLAND community of the University Paris-Saclay.
- You will publish scientific articles related to the research project.

Profile

- You have a strong command of data management and conducting independent applied econometric analyses. Command of R programming and GIS is a plus.
- You are familiar with recent economic research on climate change, land market or land use changes. Specifically, knowledge of the impacts of climate change on agriculture and related adaptation strategies is a plus.
- You hold a PhD in Economics (or you will have obtained it by the time you start work).
- You are willing to take the initiative and the ambition to pursue a scientific career.
- You present a documented experience in scientific writing and publication in peer-reviewed scientific journals.
- You have good English communication skills. Knowledge of French language is facultative.

What we offer

- We offer a full-time contract as a postdoctoral research for a period of 2 years.
- The planned start date is October 1, 2022 or as soon as possible after that date.
- The salary is based on French standards and takes into account previous experiences.
- You will have up to 45 days of annual leave and you can benefit up to 144 days of remote working per year.
- You will receive a bicycle allowance or a half reimbursement of public transport costs for commuting.
- You will be based at the new Paris-Saclay Campus (Palaiseau, 40 minutes by public transports from downtown Paris) in a dynamic and stimulating working environment with lots of facilities (collective catering, sport facilities, etc.).
